Often, a P0171 and/or P0174 code will be accompanied by a P0300 random misfire trouble code. In this case, concentrate on the P0171 or P074 code, since they are the most likely cause the engine is experiencing a random misfire.

Diagnosing Trouble Codes P0171 and P0174 - AxleAddict - A ...

Code P0174 applies to V engines as they will have two banks, Bank 1 and Bank 2. When the code says that the Fuel System is "too lean," it means that the computer has been adding more and more fuel, which is called Long Term Fuel Trim. Ideally, the Long Term Fuel Trim should be close to 1 to 2 percent.

P0174 - OBD-II Trouble Code Fuel System Too Lean (Bank 2)

Your car or truck has either a P0171, P0174 lean fault code or both stored in the pc, these codes derive from Oxygen Sensor (O-2) readings. A lean code or codes suggest that there surely is too-much air in the exhaust.

P0171 and P0174 Codes - Don't change an Oxygen Sensor

The P0174/P0171 codes (Fuel system too lean, banks 1 and 2) usually means a vacuum leak from the intake manifold gasket, a vacuum hose, PCV hose, etc, or the MAF is dirty, or there's a fuel delivery problem (clogged injectors, fuel pump going out, etc). Only after all those can be eliminated do you look at the fuel-air sensor (s).

P0171 Code - Toyota. System Too Lean (Bank 1); Oftentimes, this trouble code is accompanied by an P0174. This is one of the most common trouble codes in V-6 and larger engines. P0171 is a "System Too Lean (Bank 1)," which is triggered by the first exhaust oxygen (O2) sensor (aka upstream O2 sensor) on the "Bank 1" side of the engine (designated as whichever side has cylinder number one).

P0171 and P0174 both indicate that there is a lean condition present in your Toyota Highlander. By themselves, these are some of the most common OBD2 codes. When they appear together, it indicates that the entire engine is running lean.

This trouble code is triggered when there is a problem with the front oxygen sensor on bank 1. This code indicated the air fuel ratio is not being adjusted once the engine is at operating temperature.

On these applications, poorly designed/unreliable/ unsuitable air/fuel ratio sensors, as well as a poorly designed right-hand exhaust manifold have a long history of causing code P0171, as well as additional codes P2195, P2197, P0138, P0158, P0174, P0031, and/or P0051. Toyota released a Technical Service Bulletin - TSB 0114-08 -, which recommends replacing both the left and right hand side #1 air/fuel ratio sensors with improved and updated sensors.
